

RULES OF ENTRY TO UKRAINE FROM A BROAD GENERAL REQUIREMENTS



To enter the territory of Ukraine, citizens of other states must carry:

- international passport;
- a document that confirms the intention to leave the country (for example, a return ticket);
- confirmation of the accommodation (for example, details on booking a hotel room);
- document confirming the purpose of visit. Upon request, the team of the **XII International Medical Forum 2021** exhibition organizers will provide an invitation letter to the event. To obtain the appropriate document, contact our manager;
- medical insurance with an option “Insurance against COVID-19” that covers the costs associated with treatment of coronavirus infection and is valid for the entire period of stay in the country. The document must be issued by an insurance company registered in Ukraine, or by a foreign company that has a representative office in Ukraine or has a contractual relationship with a local insurance company;
- confirmation of sufficient financial security and its volume: carry cash or a certified bank statement.

To calculate the minimum amount of funds necessary for a foreign citizen to live in Ukraine, the following formula is used:

$FS = ((20 \times LW) \div 30) \times ND + 5$), **meaning:**

FS – sufficient financial security ND – the number of days spent in Ukraine	LW – a living wage for one person per month (as of January 1, 2021, this figure comprises 2393 UAH);

When making calculations, it is important to take into account that 5 days are automatically added to the total number of days that a foreign citizen is planning to spend in Ukraine. For example, if a foreigner intends to stay in the country for 4 days, another 5 days must be added to this period. Thus, he will have to confirm his financial security for 9 days.

NOTE!

Verbal statements, screenshots, illustrations, demonstration of mobile applications of different banks and financial organizations with data on the funds available on banking accounts are not considered a confirmation of sufficient financial support.

New rules of entry to Ukraine

The new rules of entry into Ukraine, according to the amendments to Resolution №1236 approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of March 23, provide for a mandatory negative result of testing for COVID-19 by polymerase chain reaction (PCR) for foreigners and self-isolation or a negative PCR test result for Ukrainians.

For foreigners, in addition to the compulsory insurance policy (which was in force before), now, when entering Ukraine, it is necessary to have a negative PCR test that was done no more than 72 hours before crossing the state border.

Who must install Diy Vdoma application and for what purposes?

Upon arrival in Ukraine, regardless of citizenship, all people arriving must install Diy Vdoma mobile application, with the exception of those who undergo testing for detecting COVID-19 prior to entering the country (no later than 48 hours before arrival) – such people don't require to download the app.

With the help of Diy Vdoma service, self-isolation and observation is monitored.

Monitoring is implemented as follows: Diy Vdoma monitors a geolocation of the device with application installed. From time to time, users receive messages, and in response they must promptly send photos of their face with the background of the surrounding space.

To initiate the application, you need to enter your mobile phone number. If necessary, within 24 hours after arriving in the country, you can purchase a SIM card with the number of the Ukrainian operator and use it to install the application. If this is not necessary for you, mobile numbers of foreign operators can be used as well.
